Since Oregon first began the Patient Centered Primary Care Home (PCPCH) program, Grants Pass Clinic has been certified as a PCPCH. In 2017 Grants Pass Clinic became the first clinic in southern Oregon to be recognized at the highest level (5 STAR) of PCPCH certification.



A patient centered primary care home is a medical office where the care is:

- ◆ **Patient centered**—as the patient and/or family member, YOU are the most important part of your care team!
- ◆ **Comprehensive & coordinated**—much of the care you need can be provided and/or coordinated by your primary care provider.
